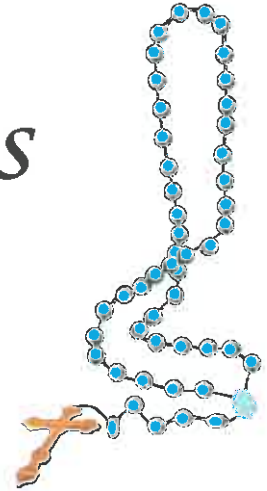




Rosary Walks in May 2018

Overview of 2000 Years Of Christian History

Twenty one prints depicting Christian History were donated to the parish and are exhibited as a border around the walls of the parish library. They will be the subject of a three week overview of the history of the Catholic Church. We will listen to the explanations of the artist (on CD). Each participant will receive a pamphlet with the highlights of each century.

Gloria Thomas, a convert to Catholicism and well-known religious artist, spent three years painting the glorious history of the Church in oils. Now, fine quality reproductions of her twenty-one paintings (one for each century starting with the birth of Christ) permanently enrich our parish! The collection takes viewers on a stunning visual pilgrimage through their Christian heritage. Saints and sinners, Popes and emperors create an awe-inspiring overview of two millennia of Catholic history.
